


## C-SHAPED L.A. HIGH-RISE GETS LIGHT 'DEEP INTO LIVING SPACES'

n their design for the 82-unit Line Lofts, on Las Palmas Avenue, Los Angeles, SPF:architects had to work around the three existing buildings that flanked the site. The structure takes on a C-formation and disperses its circulation via vertical multi-floor connections at various elevations. Balconies are recessed from the façade, which opens up each unit on three sides. "The goal was to get light as deep into the spaces as possible," said Zoltan E. Pali, FAIA, SPF:a Founder/Design Principal. Greystar is leasing and managing the property for developer Integrated Development.



he Merc, Northland Investment Corporation's mixed-use residential development in Waltham, Mass., is named after a historic mercantile building that once stood on the 41/2-acre site. The 436,000-sf complex—three five-story buildings—was designed by Stantec. The Merc has 269 apartments, 392 parking slots, and first-floor retail space. Erland Construction was the general contractor.



## LUXURY TOWNHOMES COME TO BAY HARBOR ISLANDS, FLA.
